

Comparative and International Higher Education (CIHE):
A Call for MENA Region-Focused Articles

The Higher Education Special Interest Group (HESIG) of the Comparative and International Education Society (CIES) is now accepting manuscripts for the region-focused issues of *Comparative and International Higher Education (CIHE)*.

CIHE is the official publication of the CIES's Higher Education Special Interest Group (HESIG), which was created in 2008. HESIG serves as a professional forum supporting development, analysis, and dissemination of theory-, policy- and practice-related issues that influence higher education across the globe. The MENA region editors of the CIES-HESIG journal, *Comparative and International Higher Education*, invite authors to submit manuscripts to be considered for publication in its 2017 issues (Winter, Spring and Fall).

You are invited to submit an editable, electronic version of an original manuscript in English that has not been published and is not under consideration elsewhere. Submission may be in one of the three forms below.

- 1) Regional Updates: Provides a general overview regarding current events or special interest issues in the MENA region or within a specific country. (1,000 words)
- 2) Geographical Updates: Shares recent developments of current issues in specific institutions or cities in MENA. (800 - 1200 words)
- 3) Articles: Covers a variety of topics in higher education (2,500 - 3,000 words)

CIHE follows The Chicago Manual of Style, 16th Edition B (a link to The Chicago Manual of Style online website can be found at: <http://www.chicagomanualofstyle.org/contents.html>). Specific reference examples can be found in published articles available at: <http://highered.sig.org/publications>. Authors should pay particular attention to style details of headings/subheadings; citations and reference elements; use of acronyms; font type and size; and presentation of tables and figures. The content should not be longer than 3,000 words. In addition, contributions must be introduced by a cover letter addressed to the CIHE editors with the title of the manuscript, indicating that it is original, has not been published, and is not under consideration by another publication. It should include full names, institutional affiliation, and email of all authors.

Select articles may have the opportunity to be re-published for greater exposure in *University World News*.
